**The North West Water Authority (St. Helens)
(Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978**

Made - - - - - 26th June 1978

Coming into Operation 1st July 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the North West Water Authority (St. Helens) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1978.

2. The byelaws made on 7th July 1966 by the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the borough of St. Helens under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the North West Water Authority (St. Helens) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976(c), remain in force until 6th July 1978, shall remain in force until 6th July 1980.
