

1978 No. 999 (S. 93)**POLICE****The Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1978**

Made - - - 17th July 1978
Laid before Parliament 31st July 1978
Coming into Operation 21st August 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 27 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 21st August 1978.
2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968(c), as amended (d).
3. The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment

4. For regulation 6 of the principal regulations (public holidays) there shall be substituted the following regulation:—

“Public holidays

6. A police cadet who, for the purposes of training, is assigned to duties with a constable shall be granted a day's leave on each public holiday, that is to say Christmas Day, New Year's Day and each of 6 other days, being so far as is practicable local public holidays”.
