**The Control of Gold and Treasury Bills
(Southern Rhodesia) (Revocation) Directions 1979**

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 2 and 7(2) of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a), hereby give the following directions:—

1. These Directions may be cited as the Control of Gold and Treasury Bills (Southern Rhodesia) (Revocation) Directions 1979 and shall come into operation on 13th December 1979.
2. The Control of Gold and Treasury Bills (Southern Rhodesia) Directions 1965(b) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Directions.)

Following the lifting of sanctions imposed in relation to Southern Rhodesia, these Directions revoke the Control of Gold and Treasury Bills (Southern Rhodesia) Directions 1965, which prohibited any recipient in the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man of an order from the Southern Rhodesia Government or a resident of Southern Rhodesia from carrying out that order (except with permission) in so far as it required the recipient to part with any gold or Treasury bills or required any change to be made in the persons to whose order any gold or Treasury bills were to be held.
