# The Judgments Enforcement (Consequential Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1979

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 38(2) of the Northern Ireland Constitution Act 1973(a), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation, commencement, interpretation and extent

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Judgments Enforcement (Consequential Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1979.
- (2) This Order shall come into operation on the fourteenth day after the day on which it is made.
  - (3) This Order extends to the whole of the United Kingdom.

Amendments of the Army Act 1955, the Air Force Act 1955 and the Naval Discipline Act 1957

2. In section 215 of the Army Act 1955(b) and section 213 of the Air Force Act 1955(c) (both of which sections have effect for the purpose of the application

of the respective Acts to Northern Ireland) after subsection (6), in each case, there shall be inserted the following subsection:—

"(6A) The reference in section 151A(1)(a) to any judgment or order enforceable by a court in the United Kingdom shall include a reference to a judgment enforceable by the Enforcement of Judgments Office.";

and in section 124 of the Naval Discipline Act 1957(b) (which has a similar effect) before subsection (6A)(c) there shall be inserted the following subsection:—

"(6AA) The reference in section 128E(1)(d) to any judgment or order enforceable by a court in the United Kingdom shall include a reference to a judgment enforceable by the Enforcement of Judgments Office.".

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 151A(1) of the Army Act 1955, section 151A(1) of the Air Force Act 1955 and section 128E(1) of the Naval Discipline Act 1957 allow deductions to be made from the pay of members of the forces to defray sums made payable by any judgment or order enforceable by a court in the United Kingdom. This Order applies those provisions to judgments which in Northern Ireland are enforceable by the Enforcement of Judgments Office established by the Judgments (Enforcement) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969 (c. 30).
