**The Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976
(Revocation) Order 1979**

The Secretary of State, after consulting in accordance with subsection (6) of section 2 of the Prices Act 1974(a) with the organisations therein referred to, in exercise of his powers under subsections (1) and (8) of that section and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976 (Revocation) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on 2nd April 1979.

2. The Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976(b), the Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976 (Amendment) (No. 6) Order 1978(c) and the Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976 (Amendment) (No. 7) Order 1978(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order revokes on 2nd April 1979 the Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976, as amended, which regulated the maximum retail price of most bread loaves of 800 g or less.
