HIGHWAYS, ENGLAND AND WALES

**The Llandeilo–Carmarthen Trunk Road (Penrock Bends
Diversion) Order 1979**

Made - - - - 21st March 1979

Coming into Operation 20th April 1979

The Secretary of State for Wales makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 7 of the Highways Act 1959(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The new highway which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the route described in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.

3. The length of trunk road described in Schedule 2 to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the County Council of Dyfed that the new trunk road is open for through traffic.

4. In this Order—

“the deposited plan” means the plan numbered HA7/2–WO147 marked “The Llandeilo–Carmarthen Trunk Road (Penrock Bends Diversion) Order 1979 signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff, where it is open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours;

“the new trunk road” means the highway mentioned in Article 1 of this Order;

“the Trunk Road” means the Llandeilo–Carmarthen Trunk Road (A.40).

5. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th April 1979 and may be cited as the Llandeilo–Carmarthen Trunk Road (Penrock Bends Diversion) Order 1979.

SCHEDULE 1

ROUTE OF THE NEW TRUNK ROAD

The route of the new trunk road at Llandyfeisant in the County of Dyfed is a route about 810 metres in length starting at a point about 140 metres east of Woodlands House and extending in a general easterly direction to rejoin the Trunk Road at a point about 20 metres west of Penrock House.

SCHEDULE 2

LENGTH OF TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

The length of trunk road ceasing to be a trunk road is that length of the Trunk Road starting at a point about 170 metres east of Woodlands House and terminating at a point about 40 metres north of Penrock House.
