The Brucellosis (Scotland) Amendment Order 1979

4th July 1979 Made -Laid before Parliament 16th July 1979 Coming into Operation 6th August 1979

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 5 and 85(1) of the Diseases of Animals Act 1950(a) and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This order, which may be cited as the Brucellosis (Scotland) Amendment Order 1979, shall apply to Scotland and shall come into operation on 6th August 1979.

Interpretation

2. In this order "the principal order" means the Brucellosis (Scotland) Order

Amendment of schedules to the principal order

- 3.—(1) Schedule 1 to this order shall be substituted for Schedule 1 to the principal order.
- (2) Schedule 2 to this order shall be substituted for Schedule 2 to the principal order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Brucellosis (Scotland) Order 1978 by enlarging the area declared to be an attested area by the addition of the Borders and Lothian Regions and the Districts of City of Glasgow, East Kilbride, Hamilton, Lanark, Monklands, and Motherwell with effect from 6th August 1979. These areas then cease to be within an eradication area and the provisions of the Brucellosis (Scotland) Order 1978, as it applies in an attested area, will apply throughout the enlarged attested area.
