**The Consumer Credit (Period of Standard Licence) (Amendment)
Regulations 1979**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred on him by sections 22(1)(a), 147(1) and 189(1) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Consumer Credit (Period of Standard Licence) (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1979.

2. The Consumer Credit (Period of Standard Licence) Regulations 1975(b) are hereby varied in Regulation 2 by the substitution for the word “three” of the word “ten”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations vary the Consumer Credit (Period of Standard Licence) Regulations 1975 by extending the period during which a standard licence, as defined in section 22(1)(a) of the Consumer Credit Act 1974, is to have effect from three years to ten years.
