## The Agricultural Records (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1979

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>4th July 1979</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>18th July 1979</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st October 1979</i>

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17 of the Agricultural Holdings (Scotland) Act 1949(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Records (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1979, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 1979.

2. The Agricultural Records (Scotland) Regulations 1948(b) shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) in the First Schedule (Form of Record) subparagraph II (Area), for the word “acres” there shall be substituted the word “hectares”;
- (b) in the Second Schedule (Rules) subparagraph 1(a) line 2, for the words “25 inches to the mile” there shall be substituted the figure “1:2500”;
- (c) in the Second Schedule (Rules) subparagraph 1(b) line 3, for the words “1/32 inch to one foot” there shall be substituted the figure “1:400”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations, which come into operation on 1st October 1979, amend the Agricultural Records (Scotland) Regulations 1948 by substituting units expressed in metric terms for units not so expressed. They preserve the effect of the 1948 Regulations and change the terminology only. They are in implementation of EEC Directive 76/770.
