EXHIBITION OF FILMS

The Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1980*Made - - - - 7th August 1980**Coming into Operation 1st October 1980*

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred by section 44 of the Films Act 1960(a), and now vested in him (b), and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1980.

2. The Films (Exhibitors) Regulations 1961(c) shall have effect as if for Regulation 1(4) there were substituted the following:—

“(4) The fee referred to in paragraph (3) of this Regulation shall be in the case of a licence to be issued:

(a) for a calendar year	£40
(b) for a quarterly period	£12
(c) for 2 quarterly periods	£22
(d) for 3 quarterly periods	£32”.

3. The Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1977(d) are hereby revoked.
