**The National Health Service (Preservation of Boards of Governors)
Amendment Order 1980**

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 15(3) and (5A) of the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the National Health Service (Preservation of Boards of Governors) Amendment Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 12th August 1980.

Amendment of Schedule 3 to principal order

2. In the National Health Service (Preservation of Boards of Governors) Order 1979(b) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal order”) at the end of Schedule 3 (Modifications of enactments otherwise repealed or amended) there shall be inserted the following additional entry—

“THE ACT OF 1977

Sections 97 (Means of meeting expenditure of health authorities out of public funds) and 97A (Financial duties of health authorities) (which sections are substituted for section 97 of the Act of 1977(c) by section 6(1) of the Health Services Act 1980(d))

References to a Regional Health Authority shall include references to a preserved Board(e), and references to a health authority or an authority shall as the context may require be construed accordingly”.

Amendment of Schedule 4 to principal order

3. In Schedule 4 to the principal order (Provisions of enactments to have effect with modifications) immediately below the heading “Provisions of the

“Section 13 (Secretary of State’s directions)	The reference to a Regional Health Authority shall include reference to a preserved Board”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order applies to preserved Boards the provisions for the funding and financial control of health authorities substituted in the National Health Service Act 1977 by the Health Services Act 1980, and for the giving of directions by the Secretary of State contained in section 13 of the Act of 1977. Preserved Boards are those Boards of Governors of teaching hospitals preserved from abolition under section 14 of the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973 by the National Health Service (Preservation of Boards of Governors) Order 1979, made under section 15 of that Act.
