**WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The Southern Water Authority (Discharge) Order 1980**

*Made* - - - 22nd August 1980

*Coming into Operation* 1st September 1980

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Water Resources Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Southern Water Authority (Discharge) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1980. Citation and commencement.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Southern Water Authority Orders 1975 to 1980.

2. In this order—

“the Authority” means the Southern Water Authority;

“day” means any period of 24 hours;

“reference point” means a National Grid reference point.

Interpretation.

3. The Authority are hereby authorised to discharge water at or near the points respectively identified by a reference point in column (1) of the following table into the Candover Stream (a tributary of the River Itchen) at a rate not exceeding the rate specified opposite each reference point in column (2) of the said table, provided that the aggregate quantity of water discharged at or near both reference points shall not exceed 36,000 cubic metres in any one day. Authority to discharge water.
