**The Southern Water Authority (Discharge) (No. 2)
Order 1980**

Made - - - 22nd August 1980

Coming into Operation 1st September 1980

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Water Resources Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Southern Water Authority (Discharge) (No. 2) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1980. Citation and commencement.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Southern Water Authority Orders 1975 to 1980.

2. In this order—

“the Authority” means the Southern Water Authority;

“day” means any period of 24 hours.

Interpretation.

3. The Authority may by means of any works which they may construct at or near National Grid Reference Point SU 5158 3954 discharge water into the River Dever (a tributary of the River Test) at a rate not exceeding 2,500 cubic metres per day. Authority to discharge water.
