1980 No. 1296**FOOD AND DRUGS****The Milk (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1980**

Made - - - - 28th August 1980

Laid before Parliament 29th August 1980

Coming into Operation 1st September 1980

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 6, 7 and 22(3) of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Milk (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 1st September 1980.

Amendment of the Milk (Northern Ireland) Order 1980

2. The Milk (Northern Ireland) Order 1980(b) shall be further amended by substituting for Schedule 2 thereto the Schedule to this order.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF RAW MILK ON SALE FOR HEAT TREATMENT AND RESALE

<p>(a) At a dairy situated within the following districts, for sale by retail thereafter within those districts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the wards of Ballyrobin and Templepatrick in the local government district of Antrim; (ii) the wards of Ballygowan, Central, Comber North, Comber South, Scrabo and Ulsterville and the townlands of Corporation North and Movilla in the local government district of Ards Borough; (iii) the local government district of Belfast City; (iv) the wards of Boney Before, Castle, Clipperstown, Knockagh, Love Lane, Lower Greenisland, Middle Greenisland, Northland, Sunnylands, Trooperslane and Victoria in the local government district of Carrickfergus Borough; (v) the local government district of Castlereagh; (vi) the wards of Ballymacbrennan, Blaris, Collin, Derryaghy, Drumbo, Dunmurry, Hilden, Hillhall, Knockmore, Lagan Valley, Lambeg, Lisnagarvy, Magheralave, Old Warren, Seymour Hill, Tallyrusk and Tonagh in the local government district of Lisburn Borough; (vii) the wards of Ballyhenry, Bradan, Carnmoney, Cloughfern, Coole, Dunanney, Glengormley, Hopefield, Jordanstown, Mallusk, Monkstown, Mossgrove, Mossley, Rostulla, Whiteabbey, Whitehouse and Whitewell in the local government district of Newtownabbey; (viii) the wards of Craigavad, Cultra, Holywood Demesne, Holywood Priory and Loughview in the local government district of North Down Borough. 	<p style="text-align: center;">p 15·493</p>
<p>(b) At a dairy situated outside the above districts, for sale by retail thereafter within those districts provided that the milk shall have been delivered to a depot with a cold store, situated within those districts prior to its sale by retail.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">15·493</p>
<p>(c) At a dairy situated in Northern Ireland, and not falling within (a) or (b) above.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">15·584</p>

1. Where milk is sold on terms which are less or more favourable to the purchaser than normal delivery terms the appropriate maximum price shall have effect subject to a reduction or increase respectively of such amount as is appropriate in the circumstances.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 1st September 1980, decreases by 0.233p per litre the maximum prices for the sale in Northern Ireland of raw milk for heat treatment.
