**1980 No. 1494****DEFENCE****The Army Terms of Service (Second Amendment)  
Regulations 1980**

*Made - - - - 25th September 1980*

*Laid before Parliament 28th October 1980*

*Coming into Operation 1st May 1981*

The Defence Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Armed Forces Act 1966<sup>(a)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Army Terms of Service (Second Amendment) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on the first day of May 1981.

*Amendment of Army Terms of Service Regulations 1967.*

2. The Army Terms of Service Regulations 1967<sup>(b)</sup> are amended in Regulation 6 by the deletion of the figures “18” and the substitution of the figures “12”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations further amend the Army Terms of Service Regulations by reducing from 18 months to 12 months the notice required to be given by a man who has enlisted in regular army service for a term of more than 12 years and who wishes to transfer to the reserve or determine his service at the end of the 12 year period.
