**The Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages  
Council (Great Britain) (Abolition) Order 1980**

Whereas the Secretary of State in accordance with section 4 of, and Schedule 1 to, the Wages Councils Act 1979(a) published notice of his intention to make an order abolishing the Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages Council (Great Britain):

And whereas no objection has been made with respect to the draft order referred to in the said notice:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 4(1)(b) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 to, the said Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages Council (Great Britain) is hereby abolished.

2. This Order may be cited as the Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages Council (Great Britain) (Abolition) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 18th November 1980.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**  
*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order, which comes into operation on 18th November 1980, abolishes the Pin, Hook and Eye, and Snap Fastener Wages Council (Great Britain) which was established in 1920 as a Trade Board under the Trade Boards Act 1909 (c. 22), became a Wages Council under the Wages Councils Act 1945 c. 17 (8 & 9 Geo. 6), and was continued in existence as such by the Wages Councils Acts 1959 (c. 69) and 1979.
