**The Housing (Improvement of Amenities of Residential
Areas) (Percentage of Approved Expenditure for Exchequer
Contribution) (Scotland) Order 1980**

Made - - - - 25th September 1980

Coming into Operation 12th November 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 59(3) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1969^(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby, with the consent of the Treasury, make the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This order may be cited as the Housing (Improvement of Amenities of Residential Areas) (Percentage of Approved Expenditure for Exchequer Contribution) (Scotland) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 12th November 1980.

Percentage of approved expenditure for exchequer contribution

2. For the purposes of section 59(3) of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1969, as amended, the percentage shall be 50.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 59 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1969 provides for the payment of Exchequer Contributions towards expenses incurred by local authorities under Section 58 of the Act in connection with the improvement of the amenities of predominantly residential areas. By virtue of Section 59(3) of the Act, as amended by Section 32 of the Tenants' Rights, Etc. (Scotland) Act 1980 the Exchequer contribution is calculated on a percentage of the expenditure approved by the Secretary of State.

This Order prescribes that the percentage of the approved expenditure on which Exchequer contribution will be paid shall be 50.
