**BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES**

**The Gaming Act (Variation of Monetary  
Limits) (Scotland) (No. 2) Order 1980**

*Made* - - - - - 28th October 1980

*Laid before Parliament* 10th November 1980

*Coming into Operation* 1st December 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 20(3) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Gaming Act (Variation of Monetary Limits) (Scotland) (No. 2) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1980.

(2) This order shall extend to Scotland only.

2. Section 20(3) of the Gaming Act 1968 (which specifies the maximum permitted aggregate amount of winnings in respect of games of bingo played in one week simultaneously on different bingo club premises) shall have effect as if for the reference to the sum of £1,000 there were substituted a reference to the sum of £2,000.

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order increases the maximum aggregate sum permitted to be paid to players as winnings in respect of all "linked" games of bingo (that is to say, where each game is played simultaneously on different premises) played in any one week in a group of licensed bingo clubs.
