

1980 No. 1687 (S. 145)**EDUCATION, SCOTLAND****The Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Order 1980***Made - - - - 5th November 1980**Coming into operation 20th November 1980*

Whereas—

(1) under section 92(2) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a) the Scottish Teachers Salaries Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”) constituted under section 91 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration of

(a) teachers employed whole-time by education authorities in the provision of school education under that Act and duly qualified for appointment other than temporary appointment in terms of regulations for the time being in force under that Act, and

(b) teachers employed whole-time by education authorities in the provision of further education under that Act,

have transmitted to the Secretary of State recommendations agreed on by them with respect to the remuneration of teachers of the said descriptions;

(2) under section 92(3) of that Act the Secretary of State has prepared a draft memorandum setting out the scales and other provisions required for determining the remuneration of teachers of the said descriptions in the form in which, in his opinion, those scales and provisions should be so as to give effect to the recommendations of the Committee;

(3) the Secretary of State, as required by section 92(4) of that Act, has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft memorandum;

(4) the Secretary of State has arranged for a memorandum setting out the requisite scales and other provisions in the form of the draft to be published on 20th November 1980 by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office under the title “SCOTTISH TEACHERS SALARIES MEMORANDUM 1980”;

Now therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92(4)(b) and section 97(2) and (3) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 20th November 1980.

Interpretation

2. In this order-

“the Act” means the Education (Scotland) Act 1980

“education authority” has the meaning assigned to it by section 135(1) of the Act; and

“regulations of 1966” means the Teachers’ Salaries (Scotland) Regulations 1966(a).

Remuneration of Teachers

3. The remuneration payable to teachers employed whole-time by education authorities in or in connection with (a) school education under the Act and duly qualified for appointment other than temporary appointment, or (b) further education under the Act shall be determined in accordance with the scales and other provisions set out in the memorandum published by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office on 20th November 1980.

4.—(1) The orders mentioned in the Schedule to this order are hereby revoked: provided that such revocation shall not prevent the Secretary of State or an education authority from exercising any of their functions under the orders so revoked in respect of employment of any teacher to whom those orders apply in the period during which those orders were in operation.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of the last foregoing paragraph any power, whether under the orders so revoked or under the regulations of 1966 or under regulations made before the regulations of 1966, to reassess the length of service of a teacher for the purpose of the calculation of his salary in respect of employment in the period during which the orders so revoked or the regulations of 1966 or the regulations made before the regulations of 1966 were in operation shall not be exercised save in exceptional circumstances.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation the scales and other provisions contained in a memorandum published on 20th November 1980 by Her Majesty's Stationery Office relating to the remuneration of registered teachers employed whole-time by education authorities in schools and of teachers employed whole-time by education authorities in further education.

The memorandum gives effect to recommendations made to the Secretary of State by the Scottish Teachers Salaries Committee since the publication of the Scottish Teachers Salaries Memorandum published on 14 December 1978.

The Order has been given retrospective effect by virtue of the power in Section 97(2) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980.

Article 4 of the Order revokes the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Order 1978, as amended, but provides for the continued exercise by the Secretary of State and education authorities of functions under the 1978 Order, as amended, in relation to employment during the currency of that Order, as amended.
