**The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment)
Regulations 1980***Made* - - - - 12th February 1980*Laid before Parliament* 20th February 1980*Coming into Operation* 17th March 1980

The Minister of Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 85(2) and 107 of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 199(2) of that Act and with the approval of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 17th March 1980 and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1980.

2. In Regulation 17 (Fees in respect of tests) of the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1976(c), in paragraph (3)—

- (i) in sub-paragraph (a) for the words “£6.75 if an application for an appointment for a test was made before 1st June 1978 or £7.30” there shall be substituted the words “£7.30 if an application for an appointment for a test was made before 17th March 1980 or £10.30”; and
- (ii) in sub-paragraph (b) for the words “£7.30” there shall be substituted the words “£10.30”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1976 so as to increase the fee payable by a person who submits himself for a driving test or applies for an appointment for a driving test from £7.30 to £10.30.
