**The Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977
(Commencement No. 3) Order 1980**

Made - - - - 1st December 1980

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30(3) of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1980.

2. The following provisions of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 shall come into operation on 1st December 1981, that is to say—

Section 22 (penalty for pretending to be registered, etc.)

Section 23 (exceptions from s. 22)

Section 24 (offences by bodies corporate).
