CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Great Gaddesden (Area) Order 1980

Made - - - - - 15th December 1980

Coming into Operation—

for the purposes described in
article 2 - - - - - 1st January 1981

for all other purposes - - - 1st April 1981

Whereas the District Council of Dacorum, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to part of the Parish of Great Gaddesden in the said district;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Great Gaddesden (Area) Order 1980.

2. 1st January 1981 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—

“the appointed day” means 1st April 1981;

“the boundary map” means the map printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey as “Map referred to in the Great Gaddesden (Area) Order 1980”, the sheets of the said map being respectively marked with the numbers 1 and 2; and

“the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(c).

Changes in areas

4. The part of the Parish of Great Gaddesden which is shown hatched red on the boundary map shall—

- (a) cease to form part of any parish; and
- (b) in relation to elections to be held on or after 7th May 1981, form part of the Hemel Hempstead North East electoral division of the County of Hertfordshire and of the Grove Hill Ward of the District of Dacorum.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

5.—(1) The area comprising—

- (a) the area of the former borough of Hemel Hempstead; and
- (b) the parts of the former parishes of Redbourn and St. Michael Rural which under the New Parishes Order 1973(a) ceased to be in any parish

shall be a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the Regulations and is hereby specified in relation to paragraph (4) of that regulation, and the area comprising (a) and (b) and the area to which article 4 applies is hereby specified in relation to the first-mentioned area.

(2) The provision of paragraph (1) is without prejudice to the operation of regulation 41(3) in relation to the Parish of Great Gaddesden.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order provides that part of the Parish of Great Gaddesden in the District of Dacorum shall cease to form part of any parish and shall form part of the Grove Hill ward of the district. The area in question has an approximate area, population and rateable value of 15.35 hectares, 425 and £40,060.

The area dealt with is shown on the map forming part of this note.

Prints of the map referred to in article 3 of the order may be inspected at the offices of the district council. Prints may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision in consequence of orders of the nature of the present one is contained in the Regulations defined in article 3.
