**The Domestic Water Rate Product (Scotland)
Amendment Regulations 1980**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 111 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 (a) as read with section 9(1) of the Local Government (Financial Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1963 (b) and as applied by section 61(4) of the Water (Scotland) Act 1980 (c) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with such associations of local authorities as appear to me to be concerned, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Domestic Water Rate Product (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 16th February 1981.

2. For the year 1980-81 and subsequent years the Domestic Water Rate Product (Scotland) Regulations 1975 (d) shall in relation to the definition of “net domestic water rate income” in regulation 2(3) be amended by adding after “persons)” in the last line of paragraph (e) of that definition the following words:

“less any grant towards rebates receivable by the rating authority in that year under section 69 of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(e).”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Domestic Water Rate Product (Scotland) Regulations 1975 which provide for the determination of the product of a domestic rate of one penny in the pound for the purpose of enabling water authorities to make their requisitions on their contributing authorities under section 61(3) of the Water (Scotland) Act 1980. The amendment provides for grants receivable under section 69 of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 towards the cost of rate rebates payable to or in respect of disabled persons or institutions for the disabled to be taken into account in the calculation of a local authority's net domestic water rate income.
