BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES

The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Fees)
Order 1980*Made - - - - 5th March 1980**Laid before Parliament 13th March 1980**Coming into Operation 1st May 1980*

In pursuance of sections 18(1) and 24(2) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Fees) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1980.

(2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.

2. The fee payable under paragraph 18 of Schedule 3 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(b) (which relates to permits for the commercial provision of amusements with prizes) shall, instead of £3.75, be £6.

3. The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Fees) Order 1977(c) is hereby revoked.
