(Scotland) Order 1980***Made - - - - 12th March 1980**Laid before Parliament 24th March 1980**Coming into Operation 14th April 1980*

After carrying out all necessary consultations, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1 of the Import of Live Fish (Scotland) Act 1978(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Import of Live Fish (Coho Salmon) (Prohibition) (Scotland) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 14th April 1980.

2. On or after the date of the coming into operation of this order the import into, or the keeping or the release in Scotland of live fish or the live eggs of fish of the coho salmon species (*oncorhynchus kisutch*) is prohibited except under licence.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

As from the coming into operation of this Order which is made under Section 1 of the Import of Live Fish (Scotland) Act 1978, the import into, the keeping or release in Scotland of live fish or live eggs of fish of the species known as coho salmon is prohibited except under licence granted by the Secretary of State.
