**The Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Scotland) (Amendment)
Rules 1980**

The Lord President of the Court of Session, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 5 of the Schedule to, as read along with section 13 of, the Pensions Appeal Tribunals Act 1943(a), as amended by the Administration of Justice Act 1977(b), and after consultation with the Council on Tribunals in accordance with section 10 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971(c), hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Scotland) (Amendment) Rules 1980 and shall come into operation on 21st April 1980.

(2) In these Rules the expression “the Rules” means the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Scotland) Rules 1971(d), and “Rule” shall be construed accordingly.

Amendments to the Rules

2. In Rule 26 (expenses of appellant) in paragraph (3), for the figures “£10.75” and “£5.38” substitute the figures “£14” and “£7” respectively.

3. In Schedule 2, Part 1 (subsistence allowance to appellants, etc.)—

- (a) in paragraph 1(a)(i), for the figure “£0.53” substitute the figure “£0.63”;
- (b) in paragraph 1(a)(ii), for the figure “£1.05” substitute the figure “£1.25”;
- (c) in paragraph 1(a)(iii), for the figure “£2.50” substitute the figure “£3.00”;
- (d) in paragraph 1(b), for the figure “£13.25” substitute the figure “£15.90”.

4. In Schedule 2, in Part II (expenses of medical evidence)—

- (a) in paragraph 1(a) for the figures “£21.80” and “£43.50” substitute the figures “£27.50” and “£54.80” respectively; and
- (b) in paragraph 2, for the figures “£43.50” substitute the figures “£54.80”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules make further amendments to the Pensions Appeal Tribunals (Scotland) Rules 1971. The alterations are—

- (i) to increase the allowance to an appellant or other persons to whom allowances may be made under the Pensions Appeal Tribunals Act 1943, as amended, as compensation for loss of time; and
- (ii) to increase the rates of subsistence allowances payable to appellants and others.
