Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees for Sheriff Clerks) 1980

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Courts of Law Fees (Scotland) Act 1895(a) and of section 40 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1907(b) as amended by section 39 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(c) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, do hereby enact and declare:—

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees for Sheriff Clerks) 1980 and shall come into operation on 28th April 1980.
 - (2) This Act of Sederunt shall be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

Amendments to Act of Sederunt (Fees for Sheriff Clerks) 1977

2. In the Act of Sederunt (Fees for Sheriff Clerks) 1977(d), for Parts I, II and III of the Schedule substitute Parts I, II, III and IV of the Schedule to this Act of Sederunt, and the fees specified in those Parts shall be payable in respect of the matters to which they relate from the date this Act of Sederunt comes into operation.

 - (a) When the amount of the estate vested in or belonging beneficially to the deceased, of which confirmation is required, or for which resealing under the Colonial Probates Act, 1892 is required, is as specified in column 1 of the following table, the fee specified in column 2 opposite that amount is payable.
 - (b) Additional and corrective inventories and eiks shall be charged in accordance with the fees so specified on the amount of the additional estate belonging beneficially to the deceased, of which confirmation is required.
 - (c) Corrective inventories which make no addition to the amount of estate disclosed in the original inventory, and also inventories of estate ad nonexecuta shall be charged—
 - (d) Where it is declared that confirmation is not required, fees at half the *ad valorem* rate shall be charged on receiving the inventory. If confirmation should subsequently be required, the remaining half of the fees shall then be charged.
