The Education (Publication of School Proposals) Regulations 1980

Made - - - - - 3rd April 1980

Laid before Parliament - - 14th April 1980

Coming into Operation—

for the purposes mentioned in

Regulation 1(2) (a) - 5th May 1980

for all other purposes - 1st August 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 12(1), 13(1) and 15(2) of the Education Act 1980(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

Citation and operation

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Publication of School Proposals) Regulations 1980.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation—

(a) on 5th May 1980, so far as they relate to the publication under section 12(1) of the Education Act 1980 of proposals by a local education authority to cease to maintain a nursery school;

(b) on 1st August 1980, so far as they relate to the publication under section 12(1), 13(1) or 15(2) of that Act of other proposals.

Publication of proposals

2. Any proposals which are required to be published by section 12(1), 13(1) or 15(2) of the Education Act 1980 (proposals for the establishment, discontinuance and alteration of schools by local education authorities, for the establishment and alteration of voluntary schools or for the reduction of school places) shall be published—

(a) in at least one newspaper circulating in the area served, or to be served, by the school to which the proposals relate;

(b) by being posted in at least one conspicuous place within that area, and

(c) in the case of proposals relating to an existing school, by being posted at or near any main entrance to that school.

These Regulations prescribe the manner of publication, under section 12(1), 13(1) or 15(2) of the Education Act 1980, of proposals for the establishment, discontinuance or alteration of schools by local education authorities, of proposals for the establishment or alteration of voluntary schools or of proposals for reductions in school places.
