**The Motor Vehicles (Competitions and Trials) (Scotland)
Amendment Regulations 1980***Made - - - - 27th March 1980**Laid before Parliament 11th April 1980**Coming into Operation 2nd May 1980*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 15(2) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with such representative organisations as I thought fit in accordance with section 199(2) of the said Act, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations shall come into operation on 2nd May 1980 and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Competitions and Trials) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1980.

(2) These regulations shall apply only in Scotland.

2. Regulation 7 of the Motor Vehicles (Competitions and Trials) (Scotland) Regulations 1976(b) shall be amended by the substitution therein of “£27” for “£22.50” and “£15” for “£12”.

3. The Motor Vehicles (Competitions and Trials) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1979(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Competitions and Trials) (Scotland) Regulations 1976 so as to increase further the fees payable to the Royal Scottish Automobile Club for the authorisation of events insofar as they are to take place, in whole or in part, in Scotland.

The existing and the increased fees are as follows:—

	<i>Existing</i>	<i>Increased</i>
(a) Route mileage up to 50 miles	£22.50	£27.00
(b) For each subsequent 50 miles or part thereof ..	£12.00	£15.00
