**The Hackney Carriage Fares (Amendment of Byelaws)  
Order 1980***Made - - - - - 27th March 1980**Laid before Parliament 11th April 1980**Coming into Operation 21st April 1980*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 55 of the Finance Act 1974(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Hackney Carriage Fares (Amendment of Byelaws) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 21st April 1980.

(2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.

2.—(1) If it appears to a local authority having power to amend any taxi fare byelaws that the charges permitted by such byelaws should be increased with a view to offsetting an addition to the costs of operating hackney carriages which is attributable to any of the variations of duty specified in paragraph (2) below affecting those costs, they may, for that purpose but subject to the provisions of this Order, at any time before 30th June 1980 or at their first meeting on or after that date, by resolution amend those byelaws so as to increase those charges.

(2) The variations of duty mentioned in paragraph (1) above are—

- (a) the increases, with effect from 26th March 1980, in the rates of excise duty on hydrocarbon oils; and
- (b) the increases, with effect from 27th March 1980, in the rates of vehicle excise duty.

3. An increase in charges made in pursuance of this Order shall be a surcharge of a single sum, not exceeding 3p, in respect of each hiring and in any amendment of taxi fare byelaws permitting such surcharge there shall be included a provision requiring that a notice setting out the amount of the surcharge be prominently displayed in each hackney carriage in such a manner as to be clearly legible by the hirer throughout the hiring.

4.—(1) Where a local authority pass a resolution in pursuance of this Order they shall cause to be published, in two consecutive weeks in at least one local newspaper circulating in the area to which the taxi fare byelaws apply, a notice setting out the terms of the resolution.

(2) A copy of the resolution shall be deposited at the offices of the local authority and shall at all reasonable hours be open to public inspection without payment, and a copy thereof shall, on application and without payment, be furnished to any person.

(3) A resolution passed in pursuance of this Order shall not require confirmation by the Secretary of State.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order empowers a local authority to increase taxi fares which are fixed by byelaw, with a view to offsetting higher operating costs attributable to the increases in the rates of excise duty on petrol and diesel oil (as from 26th March 1980) and in the rates of vehicle excise duty (as from 27th March 1980). The power is exercisable by resolution at any time before 30th June 1980 or at the first meeting of the local authority on or after that date. Any such resolution would authorise a surcharge of not more than 3p in respect of each hiring and would provide for a notice relating to the surcharge to be displayed in each hackney carriage. The Order also requires the local authority to take steps to publish the resolution and to make copies available to the public.
