The Trade Marks (Republic of Korea) (Convention) Order 1980

Made - - - - 21st April 1980

Coming into Operation 12th May 1980

At the Court at Windsor Castle, the 21st day of April 1980

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by section 91A of the Patents and Designs Act 1907(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade Marks (Republic of Korea) (Convention) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 12th May 1980.

2. The Republic of Korea is a Convention country for all the purposes of the said Act.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Government of the Republic of Korea has acceded to the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property (as revised in Stockholm in 1967).

The Republic of Korea has already been declared to be a Convention country for all the purposes of the Acts relating to patents and designs by the Patents, Etc. (Republic of Korea) (Convention) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978/187). This Order discharges the remaining obligations of the United Kingdom under the Convention by declaring the Republic of Korea to be a Convention country for all the purposes of the Patents and Designs Act 1907 relating to trade marks.
