**The Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979
(Membership of Central Council) Order 1980**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(2) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to, the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979(a), I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 (Membership of Central Council) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1980.

Membership of Central Council

2. The United Kingdom Central Council for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting (hereinafter referred to as “the Central Council”) shall consist of thirty-three members being—

- (a) twenty members nominated by the National Boards for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting in England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as “the National Boards”); and
- (b) thirteen members appointed by the Secretary of State.

Members nominated by National Boards

3. The number of members of the Central Council nominated by each of the National Boards shall be five.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order which is made under the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 specifies the initial number of members of the United Kingdom Central Council for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting which is to consist partly of persons appointed by the Secretary of State and partly of persons nominated by the National Boards also set up under the Act.
