**The Seeds (National Lists of Varieties) (Amendment)
Regulations 1980**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	27th June 1980
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	9th July 1980
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st August 1980

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland, the Secretary of State for Wales and the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16(1), (1A) and (8) of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964^(a) and now vested in them^(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with representatives of such interests as appear to them to be concerned, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Seeds (National Lists of Varieties) (Amendment) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1980.

Amendment

2. The Seeds (National Lists of Varieties) Regulations 1979^(c) are hereby amended in the manner and to the extent prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations.
