The Designs (Amendment) Rules 1980

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 36 and 40 of the Registered Designs Act 1949(a) and now vested in him(b) and with consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Designs (Amendment) Rules 1980 and shall come in to operation as respects rules 1 and 3 on 27th February 1980 and as respects rule 2 on 6th May 1980.

2. For Schedule 1 to the Designs Rules 1949(c) there shall be substituted the Schedule hereto and the Designs (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1978(d) shall thereupon be revoked.

3. Where on or after 27th February 1980 but before 6th May 1980 an application is made for an extension of the period of copyright in any registered design in respect of which the period of copyright current is due to expire on or after 6th May 1980, the fee payable shall be that which would be payable if the application were made on or after 6th May 1980 and rule 2 of these Rules had come into operation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules further amend the Designs Rules 1949 so as to increase certain fees payable under them with effect from 6th May 1980, except in the case of fees paid in advance for the extension of the copyright period in a design in respect of any period beginning on or after 6th May 1980, which are increased with effect from 27th February 1980.
