**BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES**

**The Gaming (Small Charges) (Amendment) Order 1981**

*Made* - - - - - 3rd January 1981

*Laid before Parliament* 13th January 1981

*Coming into Operation* 16th February 1981

In pursuance of sections 40(2) and 51(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming (Small Charges) (Amendment) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 16th February 1981.

(2) This Order does not extend to Scotland.

2. Article 3(b) of the Gaming (Small Charges) Order 1975(b) shall be amended by substituting for the words “the sum of 10p” (which sum was substituted by the Gaming (Small Charges) (Amendment) Order 1976(c)) the words “the sum of 15p”.

3. The Gaming (Small Charges) (Amendment) Order 1976 is hereby revoked.
