The Salford Docks Enterprise Zones Designation Order 1981

Made	14th July 1981
Laid before Parliament	22nd July 1981
Coming into Operation	12th August 1981

Whereas by a resolution dated 20th May 1981 the Council of the City of Salford adopted the Salford Docks No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 Enterprise Zone Schemes;

And whereas an advertisement in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 3(7) and (8) of Schedule 32 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(a) was published in the London Gazette and the Manchester Evening News relating to the Salford Docks No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 Enterprise Zones;

And whereas six weeks have expired since the date of the first publication of the said advertisement (namely the publication in the Manchester Evening News on 28th May 1981) and no application has been made to the High Court;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 179 and paragraph 5 of Schedule 32 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Salford Docks Enterprise Zones Designation Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 12th August 1981.
- 2. In this order "the deposited map" means the set of maps numbered 1 to 11, prepared in duplicate, marked "Map referred to in the Salford Docks Enterprise Zones Designation Order 1981", and signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment, one duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the principal offices of the Council of the City of Salford and the other duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment.
- 3. The areas to which the Salford Docks No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 Enterprise Zone Schemes relate and which are shown on the deposited map and marked accordingly are hereby designated as enterprise zones.

- **4.**—(1) The boundaries of the enterprise zones are shown on the deposited map by a black line edged internally with a stippled band. The boundary is represented by the outside of the black line.
- (2) The date when the designation takes effect is the date of the coming into operation of this order.
- (3) The period for which the areas are to remain enterprise zones is a period of ten years from the date when the designation takes effect.
- (4) The Council of the City of Salford is hereby designated as the enterprise zone authority for the Salford Docks No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 Enterprise Zones.


EXPLANATORY NOTE
