**The Grant-Aided Colleges (Compensation) (Scotland)
Amendment Regulations 1981**

Made - - - - 22nd July 1981
Laid before Parliament 24th July 1981
Coming into Operation 14th August 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 24 of the Superannuation Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Grant-Aided Colleges (Compensation) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 14th August 1981.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations, “the principal regulations” means the Grant-Aided Colleges (Compensation) (Scotland) Regulations 1977(b).

Amendment of the principal regulations

3. In paragraphs 1 and 2 of Column 1 of Schedule 2 to the principal regulations (provision to which loss or diminution is attributable) after the words “the Secretary of State”, in each place where they occur, there shall be inserted the words “on or before 14th August 1981”.
