**The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment)  
(No. 2) Regulations 1981**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>1st August 1981</i>

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 119 and 124 of the Road Traffic Act 1972<sup>(a)</sup>, and now vested in him<sup>(b)</sup> and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 4th August 1981.

**2.** The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977<sup>(c)</sup> shall be amended by—

- (a) the insertion at the beginning of sub-paragraph (c)(ii) of paragraph (1) of Regulation 3 (Applications for licences) of the words “if required by the licensing authority,”;
- (b) the insertion at the end of paragraph (c) of Regulation 4 (Qualifications of applicants) of the words “, or he shall be authorised to drive such vehicle or vehicles by virtue of section 84(4) of the Act of 1972 (licence applied for or surrendered for correction of particulars, etc.), or any corresponding Northern Ireland provision”; and
- (c) the insertion in paragraph (2) of Regulation 13 (withdrawal of ordinary driving licence or of Northern Ireland (ordinary) driving licence) after the words “on production” of the words “, if required by the licensing authority,”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1977 to enable a person who does not hold an ordinary driving licence but who is authorised to drive by virtue of section 84(4) of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (licence applied for or surrendered for correction of particulars, etc.) or any corresponding Northern Ireland provision, to apply for a heavy goods vehicle driver's licence, or to recover such a licence on expiry of a driving disqualification.
