**The Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks)
(Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1981***Made - - - - 10th September 1981**Laid before Parliament 22nd September 1981**Coming into Operation 13th October 1981*

The Secretary of State for Transport, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(a) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 13th October 1981 and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1981.

2. The Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations 1980(b) shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of these Regulations.

3. After Regulation 8 insert the following new Regulation:—

“Fees—Visits outside Great Britain

8A.—(1) Where, in connection with an application for or the performance of the carrying out, or supervision, by or on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport of a test of a vehicle or vehicle part in relation to the issue of a type approval certificate or authorisation for the purpose of a Community Directive, Community Regulation or ECE Regulation specified in column (2)(b) or (c) of Schedule 1, a visit to a place outside Great Britain is made, or is arranged to be made, by one or more persons acting for or on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport, then, in addition to the fee or fees prescribed by the Regulations above, there shall be paid by the applicant on demand by or on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport a further fee equal to the total of—

(a) the travelling and subsistence expenses reasonably incurred or expected to be incurred otherwise than on land in Great Britain by each person so acting in relation to the application or test (including expenses outstanding after the cancellation of any travelling or subsistence arrangements which result from the withdrawal of any such application), and

(b) the whole, or such proportion as the Secretary of State for Transport may determine is reasonably attributable to the application or

test, of a sum of £25 for each hour spent or expected to be spent by each person so acting whilst travelling otherwise than on land in Great Britain wholly or partly in relation to the application or test.

(2) If payments are made in accordance with paragraph (1) in respect of travelling and subsistence expenses expected to be incurred or in respect of time expected to be spent in travelling, there shall be refunded to the applicant, in the event of the expectation not being fulfilled, any balance remaining of the payment in respect of the travelling and subsistence which was expected to be incurred and the whole of the payment in respect of time which was expected to be spent in travelling.”.

4. In Schedule 1—

(a) in relation to the fees numbered in column (1) of the Table below the amendments specified in column (2) of that Table are made—

(b) the new fees specified in the Schedule to these Regulations are added by insertion after the fee numbered 86/2 in the said Schedule 1 of the fee numbered 86/2/1 in the Schedule to these Regulations, and by addition after the fee numbered 112 in the said Schedule 1 of the fees numbered 113, 113/1, 113/2, 113/3, 113/4, 113/5, 113/6, 114, 115, 116, 117 and 118 in the Schedule to these Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval and Approval Marks) (Fees) Regulations 1980 as follows:—

- (a) provision is made for fees to be paid in relation to travelling and subsistence expenses and travelling time where in connection with an application for, or the performance of, the carrying out, or supervision, by or on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport of a test of a vehicle or vehicle part for the purposes of the issue of a type approval certificate or authorisation, a visit to a place outside Great Britain is made or arranged to be made by one or more persons acting on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport (Regulation 3);
- (b) provision is made for refunds of fees mentioned in sub-paragraph (a) above in certain circumstances (Regulation 3); and
- (c) minor amendments are made in the application or basis of certain fees, and new fees are prescribed in relation to safety glass and child restraints (Regulation 4 and the Schedule).
