The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, being Ministers designated(a) for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b) in relation to the Common Agricultural Policy of the European Economic Community, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the said section 2(2) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, extent and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Hops (Limitation of Growing Area) (Revocation) Regulations 1981, shall apply throughout the United Kingdom, and shall come into operation on 15th October 1981.

Revocation

2. The Hops (Limitation of Growing Area) Regulations 1977(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations)

These regulations revoke the Hops (Limitation of Growing Area) Regulations 1977, which gave effect in the United Kingdom to a temporary prohibition against increases in the acreage of hops grown within the European Economic Community imposed by Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1696/71, (O.J. No. L.175/1. 1971, p. 634) amended by Regulation (EEC) No. 1170/77, (O.J. No. L.137. 1977 p. 7).
