1981 No. 1383**SOCIAL SECURITY****The Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 Specified Sum
Order 1981***Made - - - 25th September 1981*

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 6(2)(b) of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 Specified Sum Order 1981.

Increase of sum specified in section 6(1)(b) of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980

2. In section 6 of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 (supplementary benefit in cases affected by trade disputes) the sum which, by reference to the Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 1981(b), is, with effect from 23rd November 1981 (the date on which that Order comes into operation), substituted for the sum of £12 specified in subsection (1) (b) of that section is the sum of £13.

EXPLANATORY NOTE*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order states the sum to which the sum specified in section 6(1)(b) of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 is, by virtue of the operation of the Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 1981, automatically increased (from £12 to £13). Under that section 6(1), payment of supplementary pension or allowance to or in respect of a person affected by a trade dispute is not made if the weekly rate is equal to or less than the sum specified and is made at a rate equal to the difference if the weekly rate is more than the sum specified.
