**The Local Government (Allowances to Members)
(Prescribed Bodies) (Scotland) Regulations 1981**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 49(2) and 235(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 (a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Allowances to Members)(Prescribed Bodies)(Scotland) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1981.

Prescribed Bodies

2. The following body is hereby prescribed for the purpose of paragraph (c) of section 49(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 (which entitles members of local authorities etc to allowances when serving on prescribed bodies to which they have been appointed or nominated), namely a prison visiting committee constituted in accordance with section 7 of the Prisons (Scotland) Act 1952(b) by rules made under section 35 of that Act.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations prescribe a prison visiting committee as a prescribed body for the purposes of section 49(2)(c) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973. Members of these committees, who are members of local authorities, are thereby entitled to receive the allowances payable under the Act for the performance of an approved duty.
