## TELEGRAPHS

**The Wireless Telegraphy (General Licence Charges)  
(Amendment) Regulations 1981**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	5th October 1981
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	12th October 1981
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	2nd November 1981

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949(a) as enacted, and as extended by the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(b) and the Wireless Telegraphy (Isle of Man) Order 1952(c), and now vested in him (d), hereby, with the consent of the Treasury, makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (General Licence Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 2nd November 1981.
2. In these Regulations “the principal Regulations” means the Wireless Telegraphy (General Licence Charges) Regulations 1968(e).
3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations shall be amended by the addition, after the entry numbered 18 in Part I, of the entry set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

## ENTRY TO BE ADDED TO PART I OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS

19. Citizens' Band Radio Licence.	A licence to establish and use wireless telegraphy stations for the purpose of sending and receiving spoken messages on specified frequency channels in the frequency bands 27.60125 MHz to 27.99125 MHz and 934.025 MHz to 934.975 MHz.	<p>(a) Where the number of stations for which the licence provides does not exceed 3, £10;</p> <p>(b) Where the number of such stations exceeds 3 and is a multiple of 3, at the rate of £10 for every 3 stations;</p> <p>(c) Where the number of such stations exceeds 3 and is not a multiple of 3, at the rate applicable under paragraph (b) for the multiple next above that number.</p>	<p>(a) Where the number of stations for which the licence provides does not exceed 3, £10;</p> <p>(b) Where the number of such stations exceeds 3 and is a multiple of 3, at the rate of £10 for every 3 stations;</p> <p>(c) Where the number of such stations exceeds 3 and is not a multiple of 3, at the rate applicable under paragraph (b) for the multiple next above that number.</p>

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Wireless Telegraphy (General Licence Charges) Regulations 1968 by the addition to the Schedule to those Regulations of an entry which prescribes the fees to be charged on the issue and renewal of a licence for Citizens' Band Radio apparatus. The fee for the issue and renewal of such a licence is £10 for each group of 3 stations provided for in the licence. Where the number of stations to be licensed is not a multiple of 3 the fee is that for the multiple of 3 next above that number.
