BANKRUPTCY, ENGLAND**The Bankruptcy Fees (Amendment) Order 1981***Made* - - - - - 16th November 1981*Coming into Operation* 1st January 1982

The Lord Chancellor and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 133 of the Bankruptcy Act 1914(a) and section 2 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make, sanction and consent to the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bankruptcy Fees (Amendment) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1982.

2. Table B in the Schedule to the Bankruptcy Fees Order 1980(c) shall be amended by substituting for the amounts “£82.00” and “£24.00” shown in relation to Fee No. 10(a), the amounts “£103.00” and “£30.00”, respectively.
