**The Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Amendment
(No. 2) Order 1981**

Made - - - - 23rd November 1981

Coming into Operation 9th December 1981

Whereas:—

(1) under section 92(2) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) the Scottish Teachers Salaries Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”), constituted under section 91 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration payable to:—

(a) teachers employed whole time by education authorities in the provision of school education under that Act and duly qualified for appointment other than temporary appointment in terms of the regulations for the time being in force under the said Act, and

(b) teachers employed whole time by education authorities in the provision of further education under that Act,

have transmitted to the Secretary of State recommendations agreed on by them with respect to the remuneration of teachers of the said descriptions;

(2) there are in force orders made under section 92 of the Act with respect to the remuneration of such teachers, namely the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Order 1980(b) and the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Amendment Order 1981(c);

(3) it appears to the Secretary of State that effect can more conveniently be given to the said recommendations by amending, by virtue of section 92(5) of the Act, the scales and other provisions set out in the memorandum referred to in the said order namely the memorandum published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office under the title “Scottish Teachers Salaries Memorandum 1980”;

(4) under section 92(5) of the Act, the Secretary of State has prepared a draft order setting out the amendments to those scales and other provisions which, in his opinion, are requisite for giving effect to the said recommendations; and

(5) the Secretary of State has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft order in accordance with section 92(6) of the Act and the Committee have made no representations with respect thereto.

Now therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 92(6) and 97(2) of the Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Order 1981.

2.—(1) This order shall come into operation on 9th December 1981 and, subject to paragraph (2) of this Article, shall have effect:

- (a) for the purposes of Article 4 thereof from 1st August 1979; and
- (b) for the purposes of Article 5 thereof from 1st April 1981.

(2) Nothing in this order shall be construed as authorising the remuneration of any teacher to be reduced retrospectively.

Interpretation

3. In this Order, "Memorandum" means the Scottish Teachers Salaries Memorandum 1980, as amended by the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Amendment Order 1981.

Amendment of Memorandum with effect from 1st August 1979

4. The provisions set out in the Memorandum and the Appendices thereto shall be amended in the following manner:—

- (a) in Part II, paragraph 6 at the end there shall be added the words "and Part A(1) of Appendix VII";
- (b) at the end of Part A of Appendix VII there shall be added the following Part A(1):—

PART A(I)

Starting pay on Lecturer A scale for Teachers transferred from Scales in Appendix I Part A2 and Part B.

1. Where a teacher on a scale point on a scale in Appendix I Part A2 or Part B, on transfer, falls to be placed on a scale point on Lecturer A Scale in paragraph 2(2) (Further Education) in Part A of Appendix I, he shall be placed on the scale point on that Lecturer A Scale, the value of which is nearest to but not lower than the value of the scale point on the scale in Appendix I on which he was placed immediately before transfer."

Amendment of Memorandum with effect from 1st April 1981

5. In Part VI in paragraphs 23(2)(a) and (2)(b) for the respective amounts of £228 and £417, there shall be substituted respectively "£264" and "£486".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Scottish Teachers Salaries Memorandum 1980 (as amended). Article 4 introduces with effect from 1st August 1979 a new Part A(1) of Appendix VII which introduces new provisions for teachers on transfer being placed on Lecturer A scale from a place on scales shown in Appendix I Part A2 or Part B.

Article 5 introduces with effect from 1st April 1981 new rates for remote school allowances. It changes the existing rates of £228 and £417 into rates of £264 and £486 respectively.
