CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Greater London and Buckinghamshire (Areas) Order 1981

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), on 12th January 1981, made proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment for the transfer of part of the County of Buckinghamshire to Greater London:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Greater London and Buckinghamshire (Areas) Order 1981.

2. 1st January 1982 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—

“the appointed day” means 1st April 1982; and

“the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(c).

Changes in areas

4. That part of the County of Buckinghamshire, of the District of South Bucks and of the Parish of Denham which lies south-east of the specified line shall be transferred to Greater London and to the London Borough of Hillingdon, and shall form part of the Hillingdon Uxbridge electoral division of Greater London, of the Uxbridge North ward of the London Borough of Hillingdon, of the Uxbridge petty sessional division and of the Western London coroner's district.

In this article, "the specified line" means the line running from the boundary of the district along the centre for the time being of the Shire Ditch to the point nearest to the north-eastern boundary of Braybourne Close, thence to such north-eastern boundary in the shortest possible distance and along such boundary to the boundary of the district.

Town and country planning

5.—(1) In this article—

"the Act" means the Town and Country Planning Act 1971(a);

"the Buckinghamshire plan" means the development plan for the County of Buckinghamshire within the meaning of paragraph 2 of Schedule 7 to the Act;

"the Buckinghamshire structure plan" means the structure plan for the County of Buckinghamshire approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment pursuant to the provisions of section 9 of the Act on 5th December 1979; and

"the Greater London plan" means the development plan for the former County of Middlesex within the meaning of paragraph 2 of Schedule 7 to the Act.

(2) The Greater London plan shall have effect as if the provisions of the Buckinghamshire plan in relation to land in the area transferred by article 4 were contained therein.

(3) The provisions of the Buckinghamshire structure plan shall cease to have effect in relation to the area transferred by article 4.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

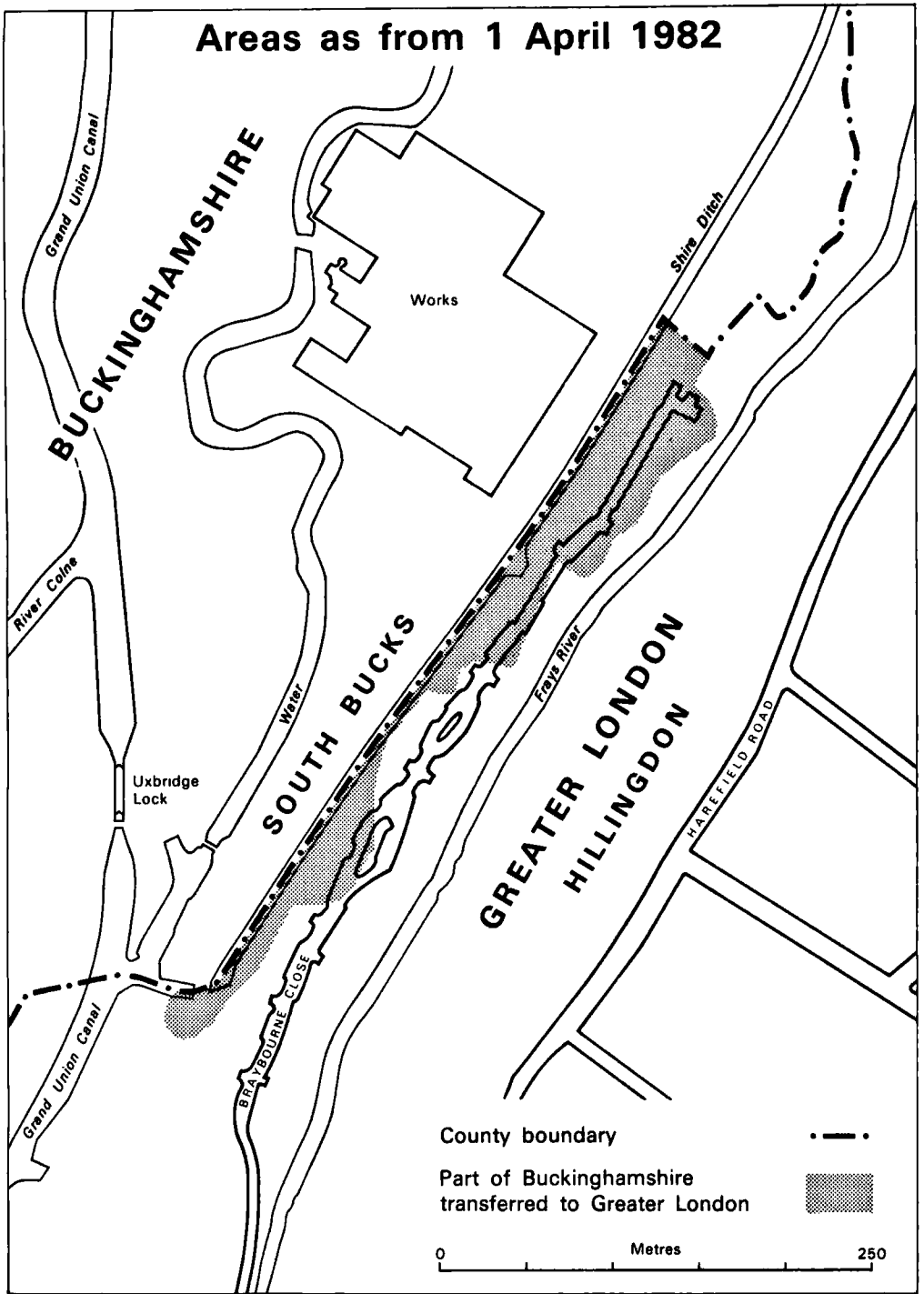
(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order transfers part of the County of Buckinghamshire (and of the District of South Bucks and the Parish of Denham) to Greater London (and to the London Borough of Hillingdon). The part transferred has approximately an area of 1½ hectares, a population of 70 and a rateable value of £5,095.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision in consequence of orders of the nature of the present one is contained in the Regulations defined in article 3 of the order.
