BUILDING SOCIETIES**The Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1981**

Made - - - - 3rd December 1981
Laid before Parliament 14th December 1981
Coming into Operation 1st January 1982

The Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies, with the consent of the Treasury, pursuant to the powers conferred upon him by section 123(1) of the Building Societies Act 1962(a), and to all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1982.

2. The Building Societies (Forms and Fees) Regulations 1962(b) shall be amended by substituting for Schedule 2 thereto the following Schedule:—

For any document certified as a true copy of a document in the custody of the Central Office where the copy so certified is not made by the Central Office, £1.75 for the examination of such copy, and if the copy exceeds 216 words, for every additional folio of 72 words, 35p (in addition to the fee for the signature of the Chief Registrar or Central Office, or for the seal of the Central Office).	

3. The Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1980(a) are hereby revoked.
