LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES

**The Local Government (Allowances) (Amendment)
Regulations 1981**

Made - - - - 11th February 1981

Laid before Parliament 20th February 1981

Coming into Operation 14th March 1981

The Secretary of State for the Environment and the Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 173 and 178 of the Local Government Act 1972(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations in relation, respectively, to England and to Wales.

Title and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations 1981 and shall come into the operation on 14th March 1981.

2. The Local Government (Allowances) Regulations 1974(b), as amended(c), shall be further amended as follows.

Attendance allowance and financial loss allowance

3. For regulation 3 (which prescribes the rate of attendance allowance and financial loss allowance) there shall be substituted the following:—

“3.—(1) The prescribed amount of attendance allowance shall be £14; and that amount shall be payable by reference to the period of twenty-four hours beginning at 3 a.m.

(2) The prescribed amount of financial loss allowance shall be—

(a) if the period of entitlement does not exceed 4 hours, £8.50;

(b) if the period exceeds 4 hours but does not exceed 24 hours, £17;

(c) if the period exceeds 24 hours, £17 for each complete period of 24 hours plus the rate appropriate to the remainder of the period.”.

Determination of body by whom payments are to be made

4. After regulation 9(3) there shall be inserted the following:—

“(4) Where an approved duty is performed by a member of an appeal committee constituted in accordance with paragraph 2 or 3 of Schedule 2 to the Education Act 1980(d) payment of any allowance to which the member may be entitled shall be made by the local education authority who maintain the school or schools in relation to which the committee is constituted and not by any other body.

(5) In this regulation "local education authority" shall have the same meaning as in the Education Acts 1944 to 1980(a)."

Revocation

5. The Local Government (Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations 1979(b) and the Local Government (Allowances) (Amendment) Regulations 1980(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations increase the maximum rate of attendance allowance payable to members of a local authority and the maximum rate of financial loss allowance payable to such members who opt for such an allowance and to any member of a body to which section 173 of the Local Government Act 1972 applies (and who is not entitled to attendance allowances) for the performance of an approved duty. Regulation 4 relates to the members of appeal committees for aided and special agreement schools established in accordance with Schedule 2 to the Education Act 1980. That Act provides that such members are entitled to allowances in accordance with sections 173 to 178 of the Local Government Act 1972. Regulation 4 provides that such allowances are to be paid by the local education authority by whom the school in question is maintained.
