**The Town and Country Planning (Industrial Development
Certificates) (Prescribed Classes of Building) Regulations 1981**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 67(7) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971(a) and section 65(6) of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Industrial Development Certificates) (Prescribed Classes of Building) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 9th January 1982.

2. The Town and Country Planning (Erection of Industrial Buildings) Regulations 1966(c) and the Town and Country Planning (Erection of Industrial Buildings) (Scotland) Regulations 1966(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations revoke the Town and Country Planning (Erection of Industrial Buildings) Regulations 1966 and the Town and Country Planning (Erection of Industrial Buildings) (Scotland) Regulations 1966, which prescribed, for England and Wales and for Scotland respectively, all classes of industrial buildings as prescribed classes within the meaning of sections 67(7) and 65(6) respectively of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972. The effect of this is to remove from the requirements of those Acts for an industrial development certificate all buildings previously subject to them.
