1981**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 18(1)(d) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Lotteries (Registration Authority Fees) (Scotland) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1981.

(2) This order shall extend to Scotland only.

2. The fee payable under paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 (which makes provision for the registration of a society for the purposes of section 5 of that Act and prescribes a fee payable upon such registration to a registration authority) shall, instead of £10, be £20.

3. The fee payable under paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976 (which provides for an annual fee payable by a society registered under Part I of that Schedule to a registration authority) shall, instead of £5, be £10.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases the fee payable to a registration authority in Scotland on the registration of a society under Part I of Schedule 1 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976. It also increases the annual fee payable by a registered society.
